In terms of the proceedings dated 22.02.2022, the status report has been put forth by the State dated 22.02.2022 under the signatures of the SHO, PS Farsh Bazar, which apparently indicates that the evidence collected in the matter relates to circumstantial evidence.

The status report put forth by the State also verifies the factum of the applicant having his examinations scheduled even for the date 25.02.2022 i.e., B.A (LLB) examinations scheduled to be held at the Janhit College of Law, Plot No.35, Knowledge Park-1, Greater Noida, UP. It is also indicated as per the status report that the applicant had been granted interim bail earlier and had been regularly appearing in the police station on the directions of the Court and that he is not previously involved in any criminal case nor is there any case lodged against him at Police Station Farsh Bazar during the period of interim bail.

In these circumstances, the applicant is allowed to be released on interim bail in relation to FIR No. 177/2019, Police Station Farsh Bazar, under Sections 302/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 for a period of three days from the date of his release on filing a bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court with directions to the applicant to the effect that:-

- he shall not leave the area of NCR;
- he shall keep his mobile phone on at all times;
- he shall drop a PIN on the google map to ensure that his location is available to the Investigating Officer of the case;
- he shall not commit any offence whatsoever during the period that he is on bail in the instant case;
- he shall surrender on the third day of his release to the concerned Superintendent Jai, Delhi.

The application is disposed of accordingly.
